

Form 4, commitment towards PEFC values

E. Vigolungo S.p.A. in the person of the Chief Executive Officer and of Conservation Chain Responsible of the factory in Canale (CN) and of the warehouse INCO has arranged for implement its procedures of certified Conservation Chain (CoC) according to the international standards of the Pan-European Forest Certification Council (PEFC), in relation to geographical provenance of the purchased materials.

This procedure is necessary in order to guarantee that all the timber supplied comes from controlled origins.

With this aim, E. Vigolungo S.p.A. verifies that all the timber that comes from not PEFC certified sources has the requirements of controlled wood and in particular is committed from now not to use wooden materials that come from these following sources:

Areas where civil and/or traditional rights are violated

Not PEFC certified Forests with an high conservation value (High Conservation Value Forests – HCVF)

Genetically-modified plants (OGM)

Timber that comes from illegal cuts

Natural forests that have been transformed in plantations or other non-forestry forms

E. Vigolungo S.p.A. assures the respect of all the engagements that refer to social requirements, in terms of health and security of the job based on ILO declaration on Job Principles and Fundamental Rights, 1998.

This politics undertaken by E. Vigolungo S.p.A. has validity starting from the signature date of the current document and it considers furthermore the possibility to:

Inform completely all the suppliers of not PEFC certified material about the process of certification implemented by E. Vigolungo S.p.A.

Inspect the suppliers whose requirements do not answer to control system of E. Vigolungo S.p.A.

This document is public in order to be consulted by all the parts interested in the Conservation Chain of E. Vigolungo S.p.A. as well as by the Accredited Organism for the Certification.
